CFPUA adds first fully electric vehicle



Say hello to the newest, greenest member of the CFPUA fleet!

CFPUA recently purchased this fully electric Nissan Leaf for use by our water treatment staff.

Last year, CFPUA launched our electric vehicle program by purchasing a hybrid-electric Kia Niro, used by our water sampling division. Based on the success of that car, we added the Leaf. A third green vehicle - a plug-in hybrid Chrysler Pacifica - has been ordered and will soon join the fleet.

The Leaf will live at our Richardson Plant in Ogden and be used by staff to monitor well sites and commute to other CFPUA facilities. We're proud to be taking a chunk out of our carbon emissions, and look forward to adding more electric vehicles in the coming years.

More water service coming to Castle Hayne



CFPUA water service is coming to the Castle Hayne commercial district.

Work on our Castle Hayne Water Expansion project is scheduled to end in January. The project is adding water connections along parts of Blossom Ferry Road, Orange Street, Castle Avenue, and Castle Hayne Road, all supplied by our Richardson Water Treatment Plant.

To complete the project, crews laid approximately 3,700 feet of 12-inch water main. Work on the \$1,537,585 project began in June 2020.
