

SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT

Using your Water Filter

As part of its Service Line Replacement Program CFPUA will supply you with a filter pitcher to be used temporarily for drinking and cooking water after the replacement is complete. The Brita Longlast Filter lasts up to six months.

Filter Instructions

- Insert your Brita Longlast Filter into the reservoir by lining up the groove in the filter with the ridge in the reservoir.
- 2. Press firmly for a tight seal.
- 3. Add cold tap water.
- 4. Discard your first three pitchers of filtered water or use it to water plants. It's normal for carbon dust to appear in your first few fillings.
- 5. To clean your pitcher:
 - A) Remove the filter.
 - B) Hand-wash the pitcher, lid, and reservoir with a mild soap and rinse well. Never use abrasive detergents or a dishwasher.
- **6.** For continued use, change your filter every 120 gallons or about every 6 months for most households.
