the temperature of the ground rapidly changes, water pipes can shift, leading to leaks and even breaks.

Throughout the month of January, CFPUA crews responded to nearly 50 water main emergencies.

Compare that with an average of 5 to 15 emergency repairs that crews make during warmer months.

While a handful of these repairs caused temporary boil water advisories for customers, quick and effective response from CFPUA's staff help prevent any major outages during the winter storm.

First Look: Southside Plant Replacement Plans

Designs are coming together for the Southside Wastewater Plant Replacement and Expansion Project. This project, the largest in CFPUA's history, will fully replace the circa-1972 plant and benefit customers and the environment in numerous ways:

- Expand the plant's wastewater treatment capacity from 12 million gallons per day (MGD) to 16 MGD
- Add a Biological Nutrient Removal (BNR) treatment facility, allowing the plant to remove more contaminants from wastewater
- Rebuild facilities above the 500-year floodplain, decreasing the likelihood of flooding during major storms

Site work is expected to begin at the River Road facility in winter 2025/2026. Follow CFPUA's progress at www.CFPUA.org/Southside.


Pipes Arrive for Region's New Raw Water Main



Our region is getting a new raw water main, and the first pieces of pipe are here! Work is underway on a 54"-diameter main that will carry raw water from Brunswick County to utilities across the Cape Fear River, including CFPUA and Pender County. The main is expected to be complete in 2027.
