In July, CFPUA was honored to have N.C. Department of Environmental Quality Secretary D. Reid Wilson and his staff tour our Sweeney Water Treatment

Plant. Leaders from the City of Wilmington and New Hanover County and staff from Sen. Thom Tillis' office also joined us.

Secretary Wilson was appointed by Gov. Josh Stein and assumed his role this year, and this was his first visit to Sweeney.

As water utilities across North Carolina design treatment solutions to address PFAS, Secretary Wilson was interested in learning more about CFPUA's industry-leading example. We shared how our state-of-the-art Granular Activated Carbon filters remove PFAS such as GenX to non-detectable levels in drinking water.

The CFPUA Board has elected its officers for Fiscal Year 2026.

Wesley P. Corder will serve as Board Chairman. Mr. Corder was appointed to the CFPUA Board jointly by the City of Wilmington and New Hanover County and has been a member of the Board since 2017.

Deans Hackney will continue in his role as Vice-Chairman. Mr. Hackney was appointed to the Board by the City of Wilmington and has served since 2018.

Dr. Jessica Cannon will continue in her role as Secretary. Dr. Cannon was appointed to the Board by the City of Wilmington and has served since 2019.

Bill Smith, P.E., will serve as Treasurer. Mr. Smith was appointed by the County and has served since 2023.

Southside Replacement Project Awarded Additional \$35 Million in Loans

CFPUA is gearing up to complete the biggest capital project in our history, and staff is securing critical funding.

Last month, the State Water Infrastructure Authority (SWIA) approved a fifth round of loans totaling \$35 million from the State Revolving Funds (SRF) to support our Southside Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion and Replacement Project. This brings the total SRF loan funding approved to date for Southside to \$175 million – approximately 43 percent of total project costs.

Securing these low-interest loans helps mitigate rate impacts from the Southside project. Staff also continue to explore options for other outside funding at the state and federal levels to help offset project costs.

Site work for the Southside Replacement gets underway in the coming weeks, with construction expected to start this winter. Learn more about this major project at CFPUA.org/Southside.
